



Call for Research Scholarships 2020

The thematic network "Remapping the Global South" funded by the German Academic Exchange Service herewith advertises **4 research scholarships** for the year 2020 at one of our partner universities respectively: UNSAM (Buenos Aires), SYSU (Guangzhou), UWC (Cape Town) and JNU (New Delhi).

The scholarship is directed to **Master Students** enrolled with the University of Cologne. The funding period is **2 months** and includes a travel allowance (lump sum) as well as a monthly stipend of around 900,00 €.

The funded research projects should be assigned to one of the five thematic research areas of the network and be conducted at one of the associated partner universities:

- 1) Governance of rapid urbanization from a global perspective
- 2) Migration and translocal relations
- 3) Natural and cultural heritage as new commons
- 4) Social movements and struggles for participation
- 5) Global value chains and transnational corporations

All applications must include the following documents:

- CV (English) with proof of language skills relevant for the host country.
- Research exposé (English, one page)
- Motivation letter (English, one page)
- Recommendation letter of a lecturer, preferably attached to the GSSC.
